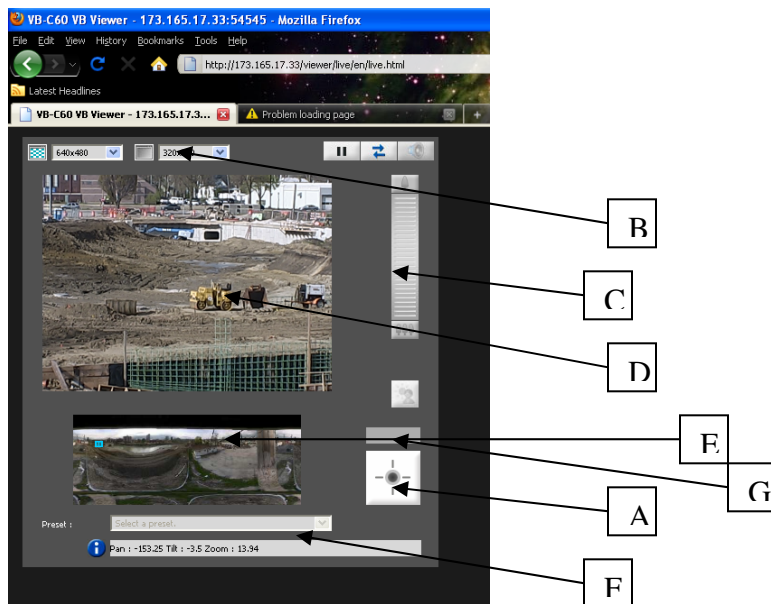


# Boneyard Camera Tutorial



- A. Click this box to take control of the camera. If the target in the center is blue, you currently have control. If someone else has control of the camera, click this to place yourself in the queue
- B. This drag down box determines the size of the image that is being displayed on your screen. If you wish it to be larger than the default, click here, then select 640x480.
- C. This is the zoom bar. Click and hold the top to zoom in, or the bottom to zoom out. It zooms a little slowly, but it can go quite far.
- D. This is the image the location that the camera is looking at. To move the camera's position, you can click on the image to center it on the location you clicked.
- E. This is a panoramic shot of the camera's line of site. The area you are currently looking at is either the blue or orange bordered box on the picture. You can click anywhere on this image to have the camera immediately center there.
- F. This is the preset drop down menu. It will pan and zoom the image to several preset locations on the site.
- G. This countdown timer displays the amount of time you have left for controlling the camera. You can continue controlling it after this has hit 0, unless someone else is waiting in the queue, in which case you will lose control

In an effort to help minimize bandwidth usage, there is a set a timer on the site that will boot you from the feed after 10 minutes of viewing. If you wish to continue viewing it, simply refresh the page.
